



PUPPY GUARANTEE - Terms & Conditions

We would like to thank you for your purchase. We pride ourselves in the health and well-being of our puppies and encourage the buyer to be a responsible pet owner by having regular veterinarian check-ups, vaccinations, parasite control, puppy training and socialization, and having their puppy spayed or neutered on time. We do not encourage uncontrolled breeding, as our puppies are meant to be family pets.

We offer your purchased puppy a guarantee against inherited congenital defects for 730 days and a guarantee against life threatening communicable diseases for 14 days from the date of purchase.

We require the buyer to take a Stool Sample from the puppy to a certified veterinarian within 7 days after the date of purchase of the puppy to ensure the puppy is free from worms, parasites etc. If the buyer fails to bring a stool sample from the puppy to the veterinarian within 7 days after the date of purchase this guarantee for life threatening communicable diseases will be void (see section a). We cannot guarantee any puppy to be 100% worm/parasite free. Sometimes a puppy simply needs another treatment against common parasites, which may include: coccidiosis/coccidia, giardia, ticks, ear mites or fleas. All puppies are dewormed on schedule and up-to-date - Refer to enclosed veterinarian papers or vaccination record that accompanied the puppy. The buyer will be responsible for all parasite-control once the puppy goes home. The buyer is not required to take the puppy to the veterinarian at this time, but you are welcome to do so.

IMPORTANT: The buyer must take the puppy to a certified veterinarian for the puppy's second and third vaccinations. **The buyer must wait a minimum of 14 days after the date of purchase before giving the puppy its next vaccine.** If the buyer vaccinates the puppy within 14 days after the date of purchase this guarantee for life threatening communicable diseases will be void (see section a). In some cases a puppy is due or even over due for its next vaccine at the time of purchase. In this case the buyer must still wait 14 days before vaccinating the puppy. For your convenience we have written the second and third vaccination due dates on the veterinarian papers.

- a) If any life threatening communicable diseases were to be found in the puppy in the first 14 days after the date of purchase, it must be confirmed by your certified veterinarian in writing that it existed in the puppy on or before the date of purchase and would require hospitalization, we recommend you bring the puppy back and we will have our veterinarian take care of your puppy at our expense. If you prefer your veterinarian to look after your puppy you will assume all financial responsibilities.
- b) There is no guarantee on any puppy for accidental death, injury, abuse, neglect, hypoglycemia, loose stool, dry skin, stress, behavioral issues or diet change.
- c) The exact size, colour, weight, (non) shedding, hypoallergenic, breed or mix of breeds of a puppy are not guaranteed.
- d) Please make sure that the pet you choose is a carefully thought out decision. We cannot accept the return of a puppy for the following reasons; 1) Allergy. 2) Approval of spouse or roommate. 3) Acceptance by other pets. 4) Changed mind. 5) Behavioral issues, i.e. barking, disciplining issues. 6) Landlord acceptance, etc.
- e) All veterinarian records must be made available to Curious Puppies upon request.
- f) **IMPORTANT: DO NOT CHANGE THE PUPPY'S FOOD FOR AT LEAST 30 DAYS!**

In the event there is an inherited congenital defect within 730 days of the purchase date, confirmed by a certified veterinarian, the buyer must contact Curious Puppies immediately at **905-393-8827** before taking any action. In this event the buyer has one of the following options; 1) Return the puppy for a refund of the purchase price; 2) Exchange the puppy for another puppy; 3) Keep the puppy, and if the veterinarian bills related to the inherited congenital defect total more than the purchase price of the puppy, Curious Puppies will refund up to the purchase price of the puppy.

We pride ourselves on the health and well-being of our puppies, and when possible want to keep puppies in their homes. Some guarantee exclusions include, but are not limited to: dental or cosmetic work, heart murmurs, inguinal or umbilical hernia, medication, blood work, DNA Testing, X-Ray, Ultrasound or any other form of testing.

At Curious Puppies we encourage all pet owners to be responsible and have their pets spayed or neutered. For this reason in order to uphold our inherited congenital health guarantee we require all female puppies to be spayed by 5 months of age and male puppies to be neutered by 6 months of age. Failure to comply will void the remainder of the health guarantee. We will require veterinarian confirmation of spay/neuter date if a claim were to be made as well as confirmation that the female has not been bred.

If you have any concerns or questions simply call us. We are here to help you and your puppy with the transition from our home to your home, and we hope your experience as a puppy owner is a happy and enjoyable one.

By signing this document you have read and agreed to all terms and conditions and recognize that this is a legal binding non-transferrable contract and you are at least 18 years of age.
